Ministry of Education offers the Jamaica School Certificate Examination

The Ministry of Education is advising that it continues to offer the Jamaican School Certificate (JSC) Examination. The examination is offered chiefly to students of secondary schools island wide, but private candidates who wish to sit the test will be allowed.

The examination, which will take place during the week of **July 5–9, 2010**, will offer the following subjects to candidates:-
